

This skulking denizen of the cattail marshes is probably overlooked at times in the GTA, as its low-pitched call may be unfamiliar, or confused with other rural sounds. Numbers have declined along with the loss of wetland habitat, especially compared to the 1930s, when it could still be found nesting in the Humber Marshes. Today, most reports come from the large lakeshore marshes such as Cranberry and Oshawa Second Marsh in *Durham R.M.*, but it can also occur in quite small ponds and swamps. As of May 2008, the database held 34 reports since 2000 (average 5 per year), some of which pertain to migrants at lakeshore sites. However, many potential sites, particularly in northern parts of Durham and York regions, are rarely visited by birders during the breeding season, and there are clearly opportunities to learn more about its status in those areas.

GREATER TORONTO AREA BIRD REPORT - APRIL 2008

The following are largely unchecked reports, not authenticated records. County/Region codes used in the *database* are: MT = City of Toronto; HL = Halton R.M.; PL = Peel R.M.; YO = York R.M.; DU = Durham R.M.; LO = Lake Ontario Pelagic, but full names are provided in the Report, except for locations within City of Toronto. Frequently cited place names in Toronto are abbreviated as follows: CSSP = Colonel Sam Smith Park; HP = High Park; HBP = Humber Bay Park (E or W); LSS = Leslie Street Spit; TI = Toronto Islands. Other abbreviations: HRF, DRF, YRF = Halton, Durham and York Regional Forests, respectively. TBO = Toronto Bird Observatory; TTPBRS = Tommy Thompson Park Bird Research Station.

Species names in **bold, underlined <u>BLOCK CAPITALS</u>** are OBRC rarities. These reports require acceptance by OBRC before they can be considered as part of the local records. They are qualified by [Documentation received] or [No documentation received], as applicable.

Species names in **bold** (but not underlined) are local rarities within the GTA. These reports require acceptance by the Toronto Bird Rarities Committee (TBRC) before they can be considered as valid records. They are qualified by [Documentation received] or [No documentation received], as applicable.

Individual species marked * or specific reports marked * indicate unusual local observations for which documentation is requested by TBRC and/or TOC Records Committee by virtue of rarity, difficulty of ID, extreme dates (early, late, unseasonal) or high counts.

Species names in [square brackets] indicate reports believed to relate to escaped or released birds, or to introduced birds which have not yet become established.

Names in *ITALICS* indicate subspecies, hybrids, morphs or other 'recognizable forms', which may be identifiable in the field. This does not necessarily imply that the compilers agree with such designations, or accept their validity.

- AMERICAN ROBIN 6 reports from TI from 3rd to 22nd with high counts of 275 (75% flying W) on 8th (NMu,MVL) & 150 on 10th (NMu,ICa,&).
- GRAY CATBIRD 1 at Thicksons Woods, *Durham* on 29th (anon fide TWRB, fide DRBA).
- NORTHERN MOCKINGBIRD A total of 84 reports this month, with 30 from *Toronto*, 35 from *York*, 10 from *Durham*, 9 from *Peel* and none from *Halton*. The lack of reports from Halton is clearly related to reduced survey effort by RBHS & WP. The first nest (complete and lined) was seen on 19th at Whitby, *Durham*, and by 27th this nest had 3 eggs, yielding a calculated first egg date of 25th (RBHS, WP). Singles at Thicksons Woods, *Durham* on 13th (RPye fide DRBA), Lick's Pond, Whitby, *Durham* on 19th (DRuch fide DRBA) & at 218 Humbercrest Blvd. (area) on 20th (JRC). 2 at LSS on 18th, 8 on 20th, 3 on 23rd (TTPBRS,DDe) & 2 on 27th (JBMW,HC).
- AMERICAN PIPIT 1 at Peninsula D, LSS on 7th, 1 on 10th & 2 on 27th (DDe,TTPBRS).
- BOHEMIAN WAXWING As was done for March, the reports are listed in detail to provide a full picture of the irruption.
- In *Durham*, there were 4 at West Beach Rd (S end of Liberty St), Bowmanville on 2nd (Anna V fide ONTBIRDS) & 20 at Park Rd S of Gibb St, Oshawa on 2nd (S. Pernanen fide DRBA). On the 5th ~300 were noted at South Blair St, Whitby (JFa), 230 at Lakeridge Rd, 2km S of Dagmar (JKa fide DRBA) & 130 beside Shoppers Drug Mart at Westney Rd, N of Hwy 2, Ajax (RPye fide DRBA). Another 45 were at Oshawa City Hall (Center St & Bagot) on 2nd & 3rd (DRuch fide DRBA), with 190 there on 5th, and 85 on 6th (RPye fide DRBA). There were 'only 2 crabapple trees left with fruit on them' & 35 birds there on 8th (J. Skene fide DRBA). 8 at Oshawa Second Marsh on 11th (THo fide ONTBIRDS) & 2 at Oshawa Centre Shopping Mall on 16th (DRuch fide DRBA).

In *York*, 35 were found at 600 Alden Rd, Markham on 2nd, 120 on 3rd (Siegmar Bodach fide ONTBIRDS) & 38 there on 5th (RBHS,WP), when they were feeding on newly-opened flowers (stamens) of a maple species and also sometimes on a nearby Highbush Cranberry. Another 40 were at Armenian Evangelical Church, Markham on 5th (RBHS,WP), and 30+ feeding on Juniper berries at Hwy 7 & Wootten Way, Markham on 7th (SLo fide ONTBIRDS), as well as 60 at Don Park & Dennison Ave on 8th (DW). 50-150 were seen on several dates at Bolton Ave, Newmarket during the week ending 5 Apr (Chris Dunn fide RJF, fide ONTBIRDS) & 5 more at 310 St Francis Ave, Woodbridge on 13th (AA).

For *Toronto* itself, 10 were at Overlea Blvd & Millwood on 2nd (ETB), 20 at Sheppard & Willowdale on 4th (DW), 100 at Bluffer's Park on 5th (anon fide OUTON) & 71 at Hillside Gardens, HP on 6th (GC). 71 (flock 68 + 3) at TI on 3rd (NMu fide ONTBIRDS) & 300 on 8th (NMu,MVL), in 3 groups: 200 on Wards beside Eastern Gap, 75 on Algonquin, and 25 on Snake Island. 25 at Ward's Island, TI on 10th (HE), 1 at Snug Harbour, TI on 15th, 16th & 17th & 9 there on 24th (NMu,&). A flock of 52 at Peninsula D, LSS on 8th was the first record for TTPBRS & 23 were there on 10th (anon,TTPBRS). 3 at 59 Baby Point Rd, Etobicoke on 15th & 2 on 16th (VC, JRC). 1at Centennial Golf Course on 16th (IDMF fide OUTON). One at 78 North Hills Terr, Don Mills on 19th & 20th was reported as sipping sap oozing out of a birch tree, with about 17 Cedar Waxwings (KK fide ONTBIRDS), while the last report was of 24 at Mount Pleasant Cemetery on 23rd (HE).

In *Peel*, 2 at Rattray Marsh on 3rd (WER fide ONTBIRDS), were feeding on Climbing Bittersweet; 32 were at Valleywood Blvd, N of Brampton on 5th (ARa fide BB), & 60 (in am) at Queen St & Dixie, Brampton on 7th (Neil Baker fide ONTBIRDS), feeding in 'fruit trees' in front of Bramalea City Centre, with a few Cedar Waxwings mixed in. 2 at Pony Ranch Drive, Claireville C. A. on 11th (John Thompson fide ONTBIRDS), were all that remained of 20 seen there earlier in the week. The last report was of 7 at Meadowvale GO Station @ 16:45hrs on 13th (RBHS, WP), feeding on crabapples with about 50 Cedar Waxwings.

In *Halton*, the largest single count of this irruption involved 500+ at 6th Line S of 10th SR on 5th (DEP). Here, in an old orchard about 200m S of the intersection, where three or four rows of apple trees had been bulldozed and all the apples from last year left to rot, the waxwings were feasting.
