

The spring migration of Short-billed Dowitcher in the GTA extends from 13 May to 17 June. These are the extreme dates currently recorded in the TOC Database, but the records are still incomplete as regards some historic data. The peak of migration falls in the period 15 – 27 May, while the highest spring count was 126 at Nonquon Sewage Lagoons, *Durham R.M.* on 15 May 1990 (Brian Henshaw). Interestingly, most high counts have occurred between 15 – 19 May, quite early in the migration period, but most reports fall within the period 18 -28 May. A large majority of all reports (85%) involved 10 or fewer birds.

In contrast, the Long-billed Dowitcher is a rare spring migrant in the GTA, with just 10 occurrences (19 reports) in the Database since 1978. However, only one of these has been documented and accepted by TBRC, and some of the others may be invalid. The dates of those believed to be valid range from 23 April -5 May, with one outlying report from 19-21 May 1997.

GREATER TORONTO AREA BIRD REPORT - APRIL 2009

The following are largely unchecked reports, not authenticated records. County/Region codes used in the *database* are: MT = City of Toronto; HL = Halton R.M.; PL = Peel R.M.; YO = York R.M.; DU = Durham R.M.; LO = Lake Ontario Pelagic, but full names are provided in the Report, except for locations within City of Toronto. Frequently cited place names in Toronto are abbreviated as follows: CSSP = Colonel Sam Smith Park; HP = High Park; HBP = Humber Bay Park (E or W); LSS = Leslie Street Spit; TI = Toronto Islands. Other abbreviations: HRF, DRF, YRF = Halton, Durham and York Regional Forests, respectively. TBO = Toronto Bird Observatory; TTPBRS = Tommy Thompson Park Bird Research Station.

Species names in **bold, underlined BLOCK CAPITALS** are OBRC rarities. These reports require acceptance by OBRC before they can be considered as part of the local records. They are qualified by [Documentation received] or [No documentation received], as applicable.

Species names in **bold** (but not underlined) are local rarities within the GTA. These reports require documentation and acceptance by the Toronto Bird Rarities Committee (TBRC) before they can be considered as valid records. They are qualified by [Documentation received] or [No documentation received], as applicable.

Individual species **marked * or specific reports marked *** indicate unusual local observations for which documentation is requested by TBRC and/or TOC Records Committee by virtue of rarity, difficulty of ID, extreme dates (early, late, unseasonal) or high counts.

Species names in [square brackets] indicate reports believed to relate to escaped or released birds, or to introduced birds which have not yet become established.

Names in *ITALICS* indicate subspecies, hybrids, morphs or other 'recognizable forms', which may be identifiable in the field. This does not necessarily imply that the compilers agree with such designations, or accept their validity.

Other reports of possible breeding came from the 'Bowl' area of CSSP [2 on territory (?) on 24th (LF fide ONTBIRDS)]; 2 pairs at Rattray Marsh, *Peel* on 26th (WER fide ONTBIRDS) and Grenfell Rd, Markham, *York* on 27th, where a lone F was seen, and a M had been singing during the previous week (CMcK fide ONTBIRDS). Spring Dowitcher Identification

Comparison of two subspecies of the Short-billed Dowitcher at Reesor Pond in Markham with a Long-billed Dowitcher at Hillman Marsh near Point Pelee

Photo 1. Two subspecies of Short-billed Dowitcher occur in Ontario. This is a typical nominate or eastern *Limnodromus griseus griseus*. It is much rarer than the interior *hendersoni* subspecies in photo 2 in the GTA because it breeds mainly in northern Quebec. Nominate *griseus* differs from *hendersoni* by its heavily spotted breast and the cinnamon colour is restricted mainly to the upper breast and neck. 20 May 2009, Reesor Pond, Markham, *York*. © *Jean Iron*.



Photo 2. Compared to the *griseus* in photo 1, this *hendersoni* is more lightly spotted below and the cinnamon colour extends back of the legs. It suggests a Long-billed Dowitcher in photo 3, but that species is heavily spotted on the foreneck and has well-formed bars, rather than the spots of *hendersoni*, on the sides of breast. Caution: both Short-billed and Long-billed Dowitchers can have barring on the sides and flanks. 20 May 2009, Reesor Pond, Markham, *York*. © *Jean Iron*.



Photo 3. The Long-billed Dowitcher is monotypic (no subspecies). The cinnamon extends to the undertail coverts and it is heavily spotted on the neck and barred on the sides. Long-billed is easily separated from the eastern *griseus* Short-billed Dowitcher in photo 1, which has extensive white on the belly. Separation from *hendersoni* is often difficult; see photo 2 and caption. 17 May 2009, Hillman Marsh Conservation Area near Point Pelee. © *Jean Iron*.

More Information

The best identification descriptions and illustrations comparing Short-billed and Long-billed Dowitchers are on pages 180 and 181 in the fourth and fifth editions of the National Geographic Field Guide to the Birds of North America. The three subspecies of the Short-billed Dowitchers are well illustrated. Also note the very different appearance of Long-billed Dowitchers in fresh and worn alternate (breeding) plumage.
