

# **GREATER TORONTO AREA BIRD REPORT – JANUARY 2010**

The following are largely unchecked reports, not authenticated records. County/Region codes used in the *database* are: MT = City of Toronto; HL = Halton R.M.; PL = Peel R.M.; YO = York R.M.; DU = Durham R.M.; LO = Lake Ontario Pelagic, but full names are provided in the Report, except for locations within City of Toronto. Frequently cited place names in Toronto are abbreviated as follows: CSSP = Colonel Sam Smith Park; HP = High Park; HBP = Humber Bay Park (E or W); LSS = Leslie Street Spit; TI = Toronto Islands. Other abbreviations: HRF, DRF, YRF = Halton, Durham and York Regional Forests, respectively. TBO = Toronto Bird Observatory; TTPBRS = Tommy Thompson Park Bird Research Station.

Species names in **bold, underlined <u>BLOCK CAPITALS</u>** are OBRC rarities. These reports require acceptance by OBRC before they can be considered as part of the local records. They are qualified by [Documentation received] or [No documentation received], as applicable.

Species names in **bold** (but not underlined) are local rarities within the GTA. These reports require documentation and acceptance by the Toronto Bird Rarities Committee (TBRC) before they can be considered as valid records. They are qualified by [Documentation received] or [No documentation received], as applicable.

Individual species **marked \* or specific reports marked \*** indicate unusual local observations for which documentation is requested by TBRC and/or TOC Records Committee by virtue of rarity, difficulty of ID, extreme dates (early, late, unseasonal) or high counts.

Species names in [square brackets] indicate reports believed to relate to escaped or released birds, or to introduced birds which have not yet become established.

Names in *ITALICS* indicate subspecies, hybrids, morphs or other 'recognizable forms', which may be identifiable in the field. This does not necessarily imply that the compilers agree with such designations, or accept their validity.

It was seen for 5 minutes there on 11<sup>th</sup> (KGB fide HBGG) but was not seen on 12<sup>th</sup> (Julia Freedman fide ONTBIRDS), nor reported thereafter.

# The Varied Thrush at Cold Creek Conservation Area in 2010

On Tuesday morning, 5 January 2010, when Geoff Simpson glanced out of his window, he was quite surprised to see a male Varied Thrush on the driveway there. The bird had been attracted to whole corn that Geoff had put out on several 'logs on end'; it was subsequently seen in various places in and around the front yard, where it settled down to overwinter; staying to 2 April. Geoff's house is situated less than 100m from the entrance gate on the north border of the 190-hectare Cold Creek Conservation Area in King Township, York. Within the Cold Creek C.A. there is a large pine plantation on the north side, and extensive coniferous forests to the south, with Cold Creek (a tributary of the Humber River) running N-S through the middle. These are valuable conservation lands serving the needs of local communities like Nobleton and Bolton, as well as residents even further afield.

According to known reports of Varied Thrush in the Greater Toronto Area (GTA) since 1962, the Cold Creek C.A. bird was the 35th individual reported. Although not all of these have been properly documented, most of the sightings are reliable enough to be acceptable, while several were also photographed. Documentation of the species in southern Ontario was no longer required after 1 January 1994 by the Ontario Bird Records Committee (OBRC) (Pittaway 1995), but is still required for GTA records by the Toronto Bird Rarities Committee (TBRC).

Of the six Varied Thrush previously recorded in *York*, it is interesting to note that one involved a bird at northwest Nobleton in December 1990, specifically at 22 Hillside Avenue, which is only 4 km from Geoff Simpson's house. The precise dates for this 1990 record are not available because it was suppressed at the time – "This bird, whose whereabouts have been beclouded by the resident at the address given because he resents arrival of a lot of birders, has been reported as present on several dates through January" (Gerry Bennett, TOC database). In the same winter, a Varied Thrush was also seen for one day only on 14 December 1990 by

Joan Love on her property at Major Mackenzie and Highway 27 (about 8.5 km south southeast of the Nobleton location), however, this bird could have moved to Nobleton later on. If one ignores this possibility, the Cold Creek Varied Thrush would be the seventh record for *York*. The first *York* record was also the second Ontario record – a female at Maple on 25 December 1963; it was eventually collected for the ROM, specimen #93842, and determined to be of the race *meruloides* (the inland form) (Baldwin 1964).
